- Get both Speakers out of the box and connect them to Power



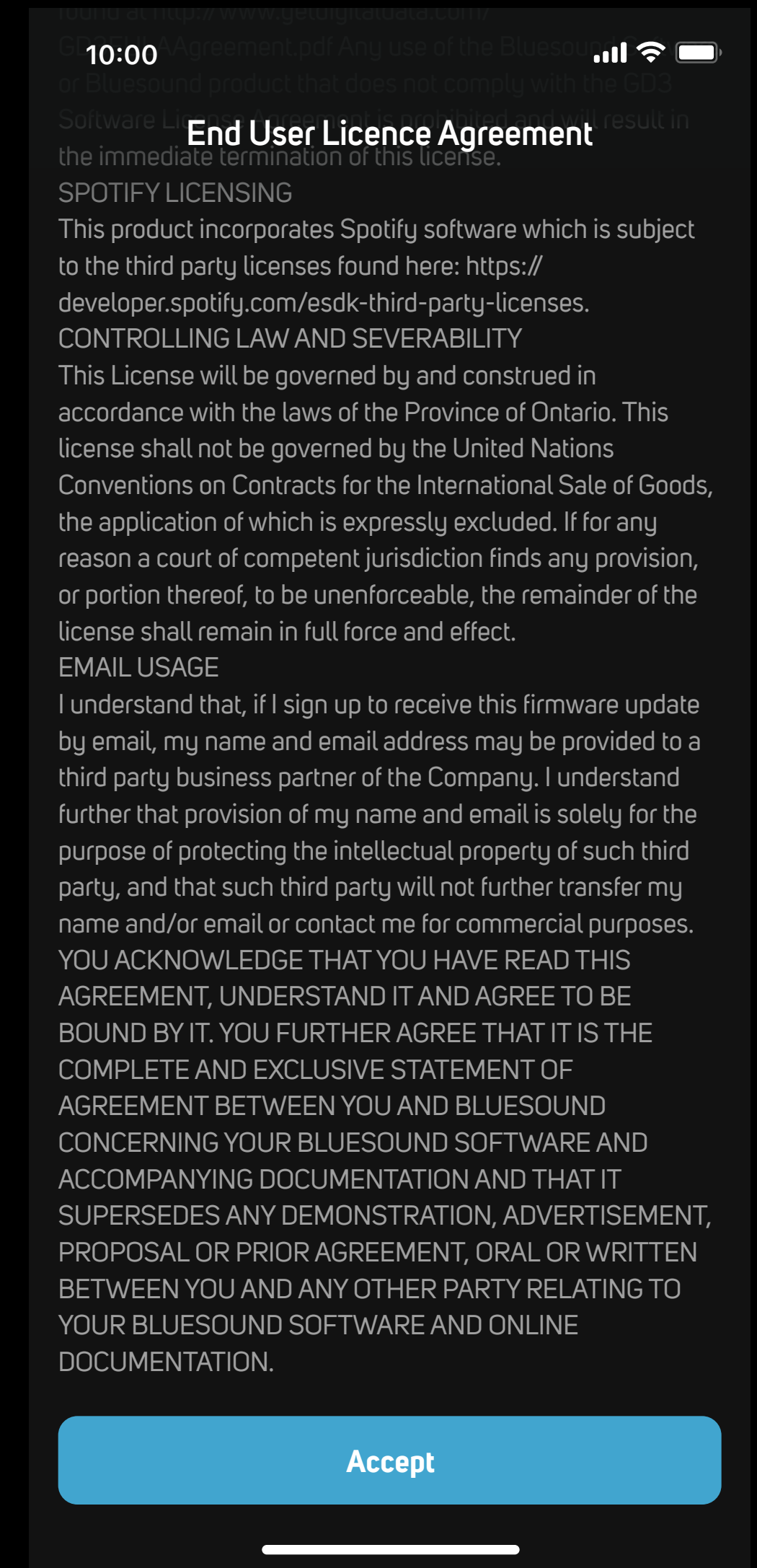
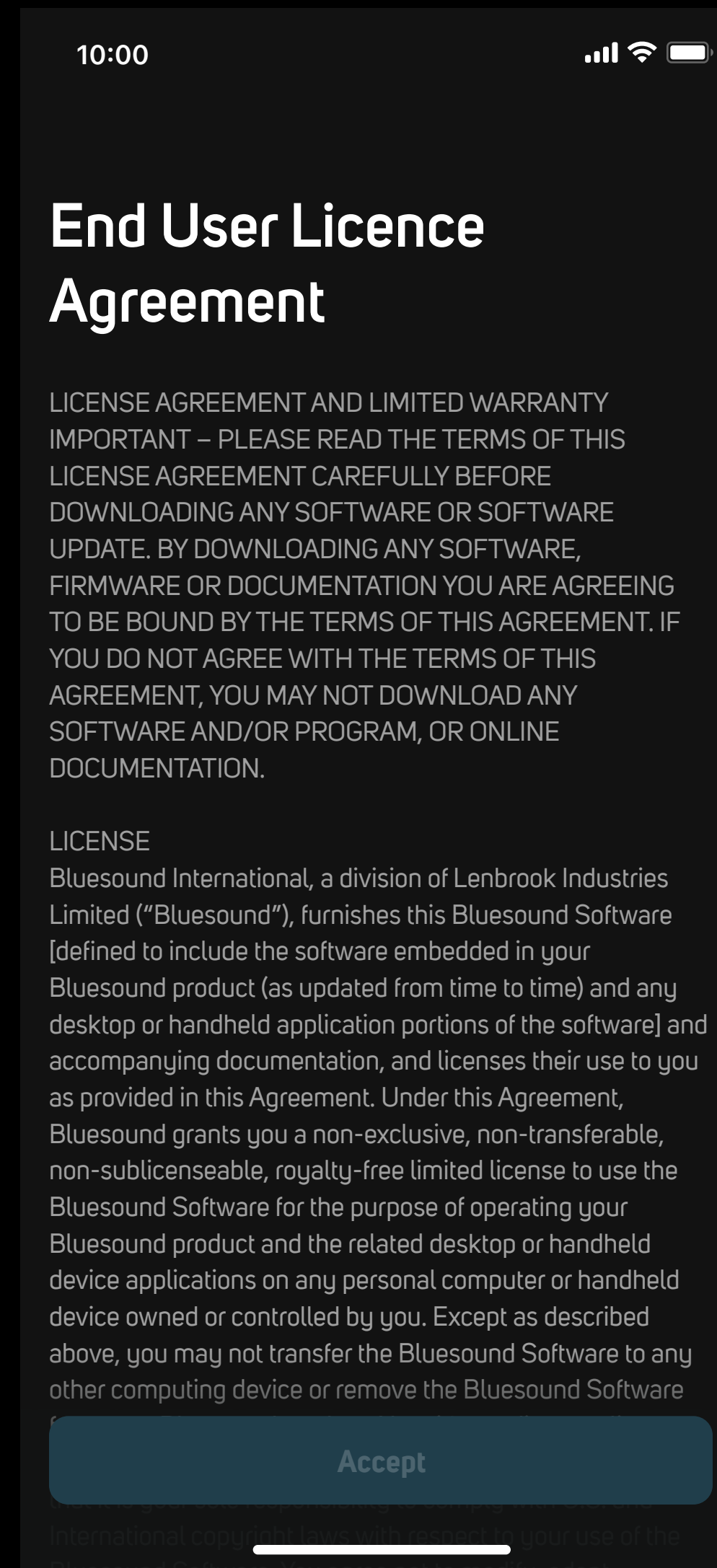

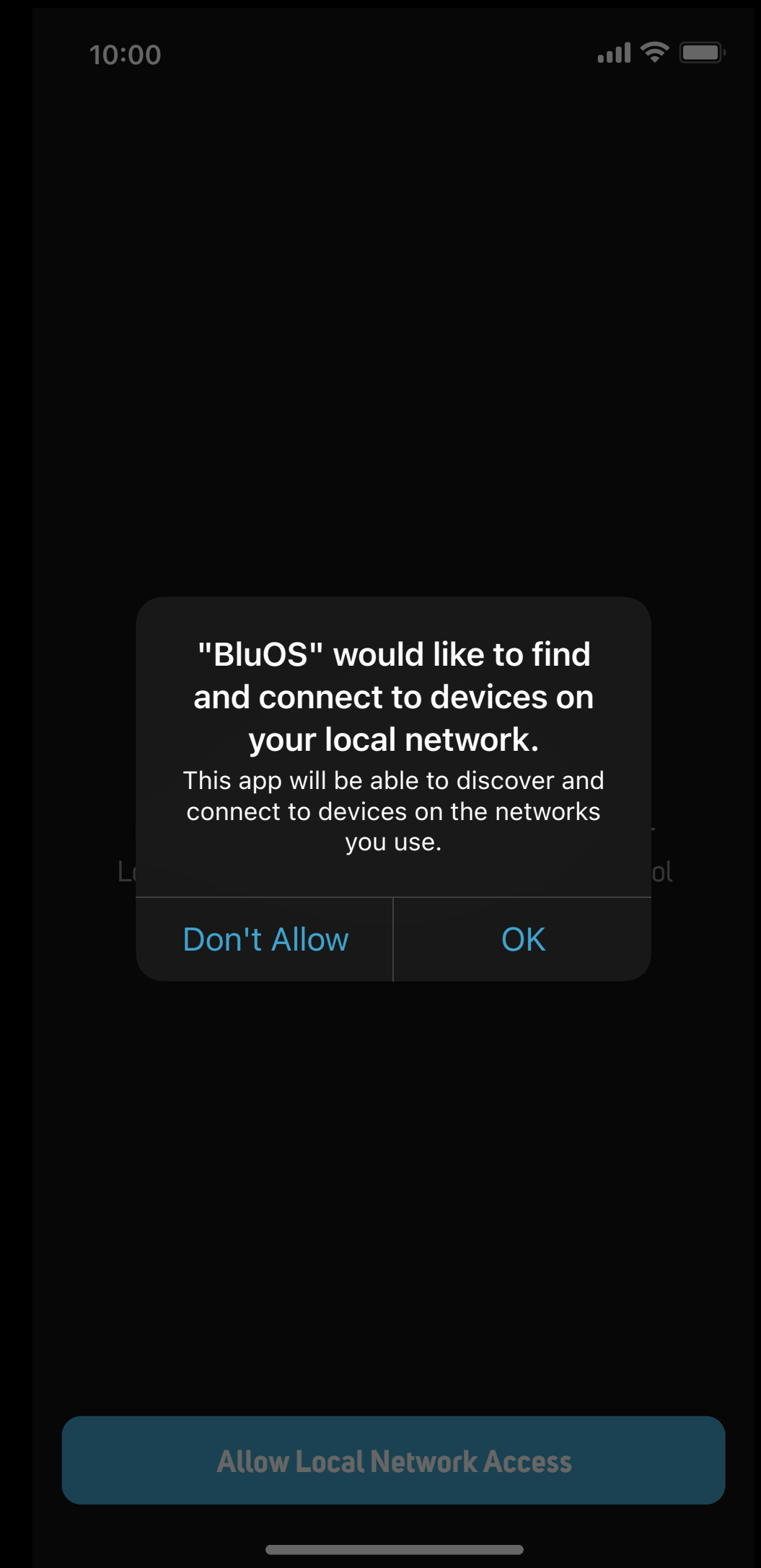
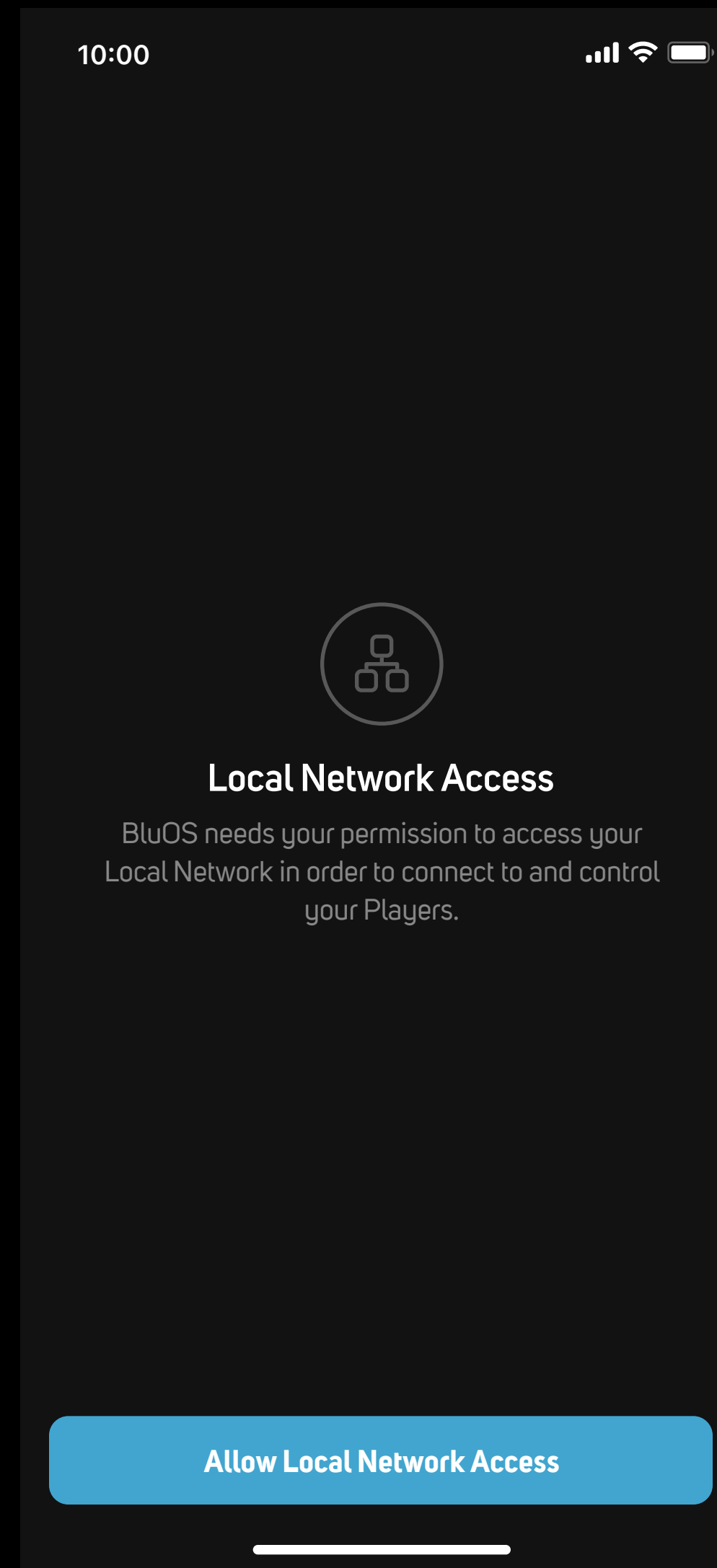
End User License Agreement

- Click „Accept“ to continue



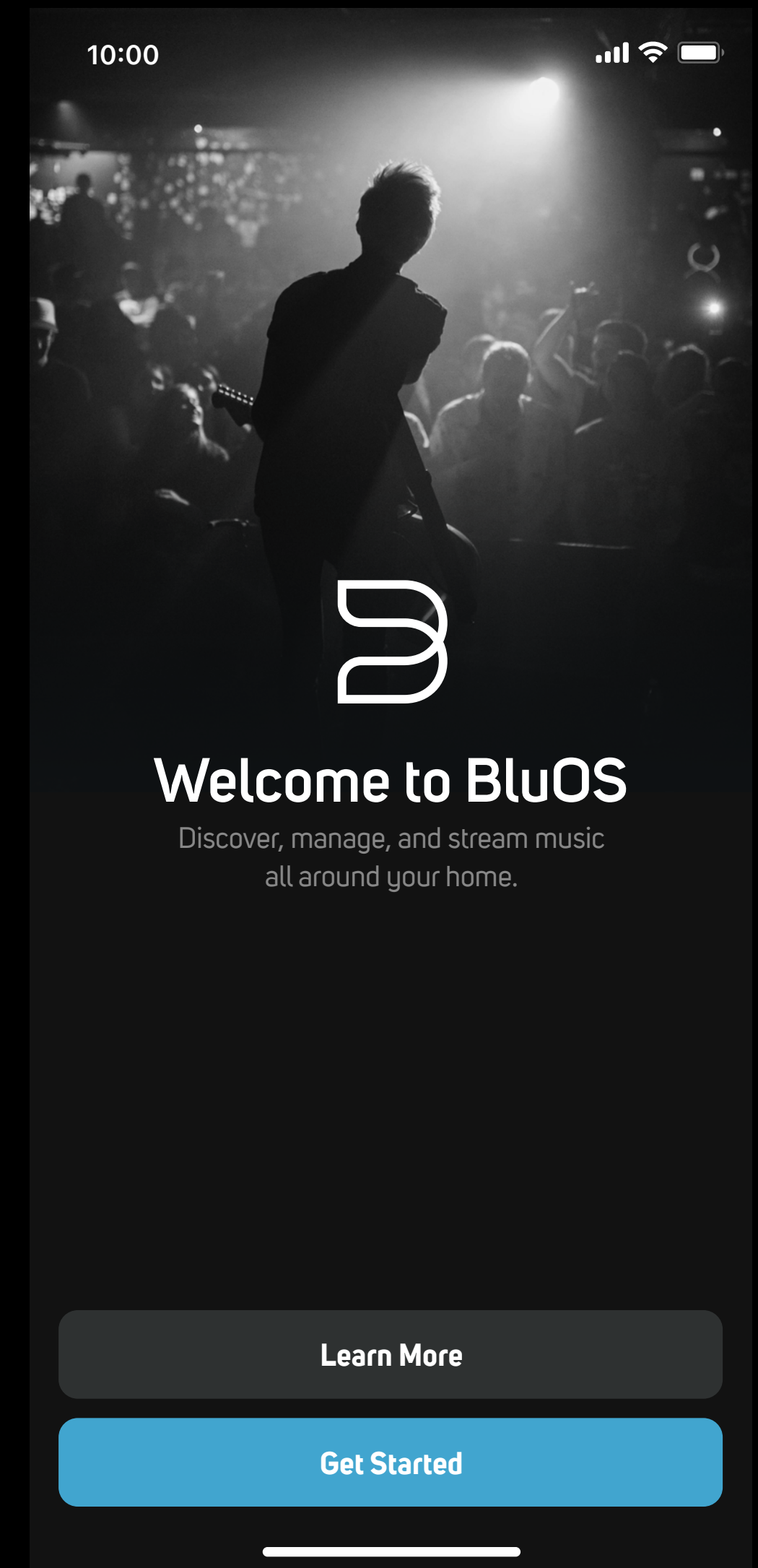
Local Network Access

- Click „Get Started“ Button to begin the Setup Process

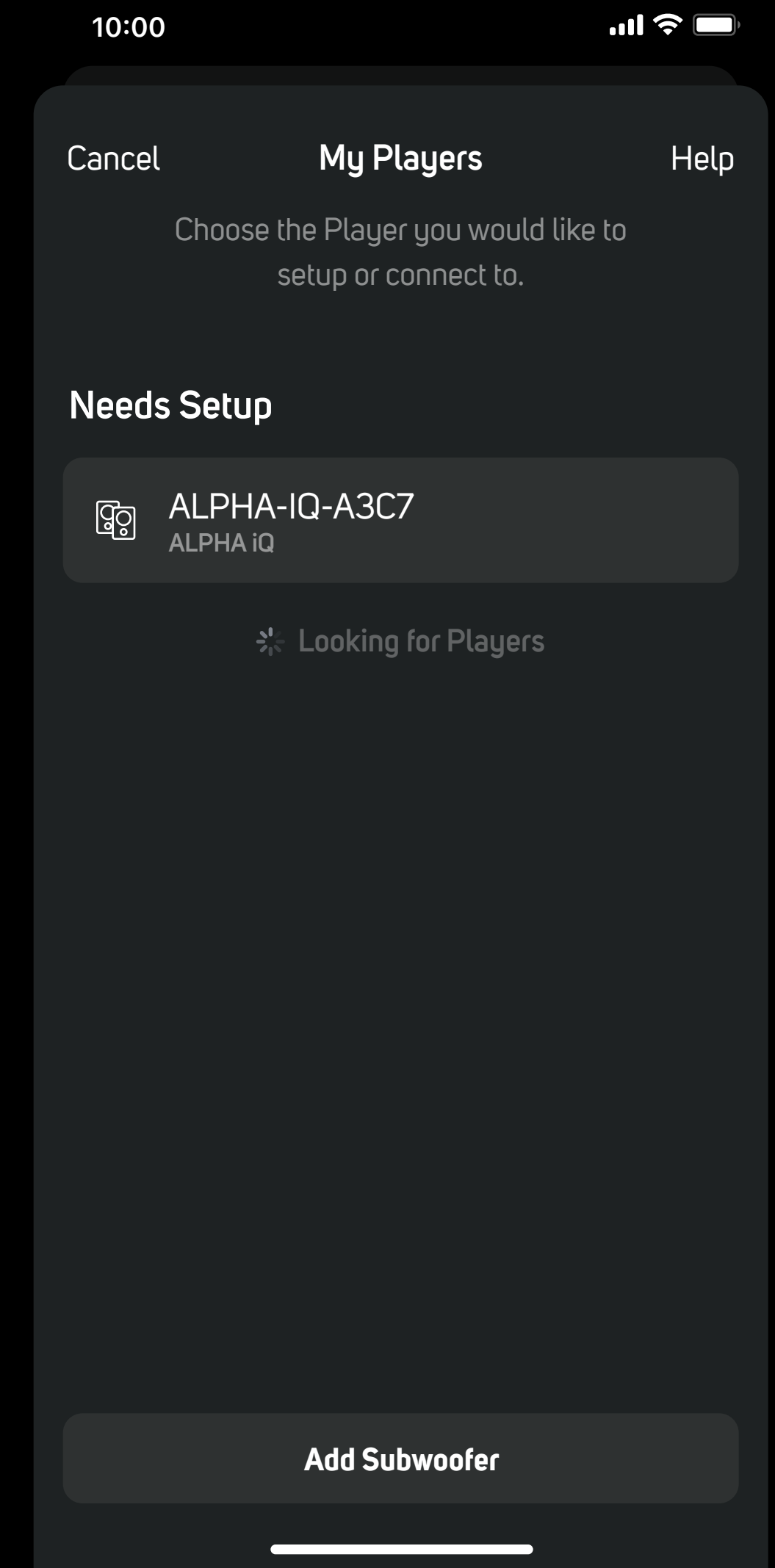
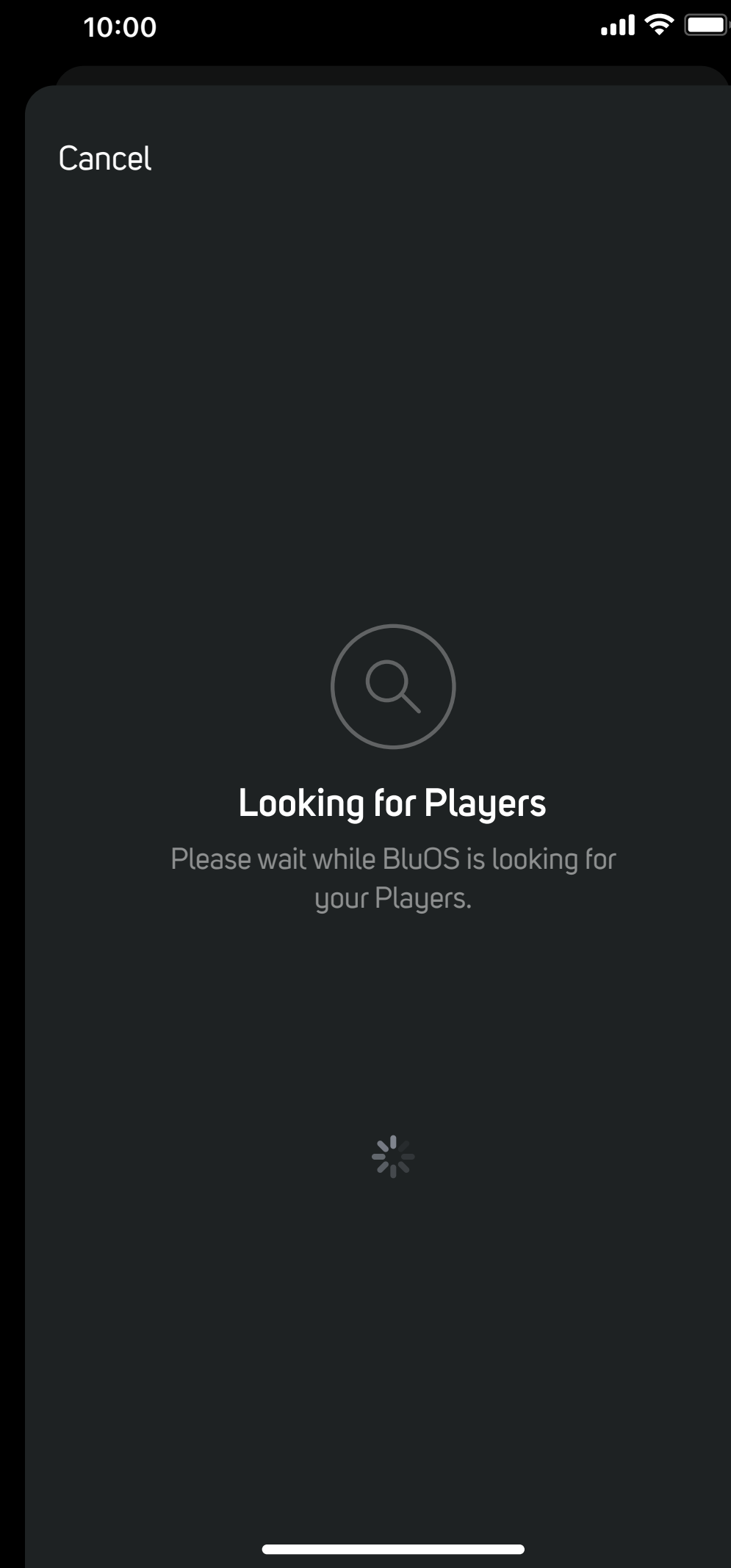


Looking for Players

- After it found a Player click on it to start the setup of that Player

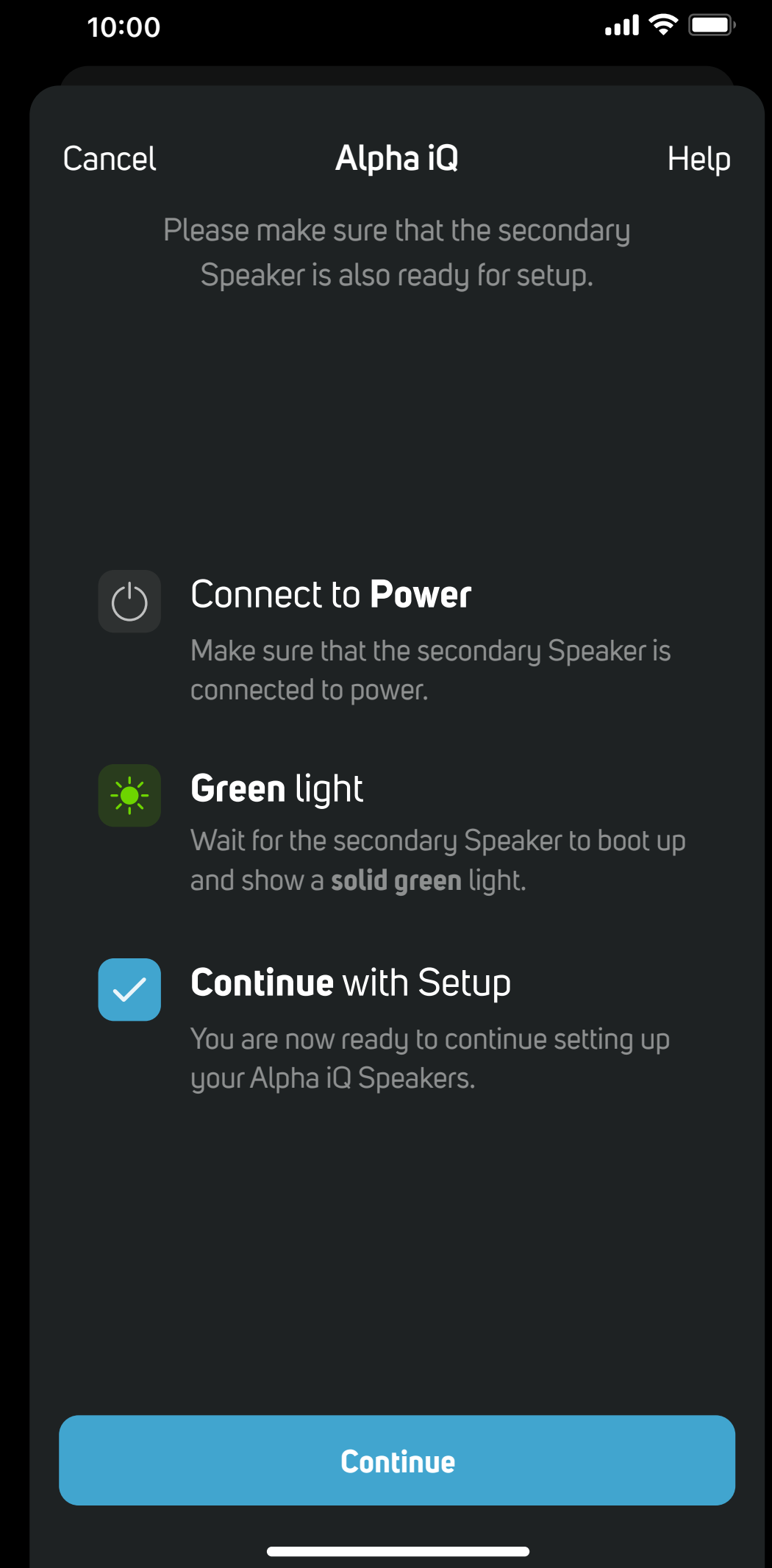

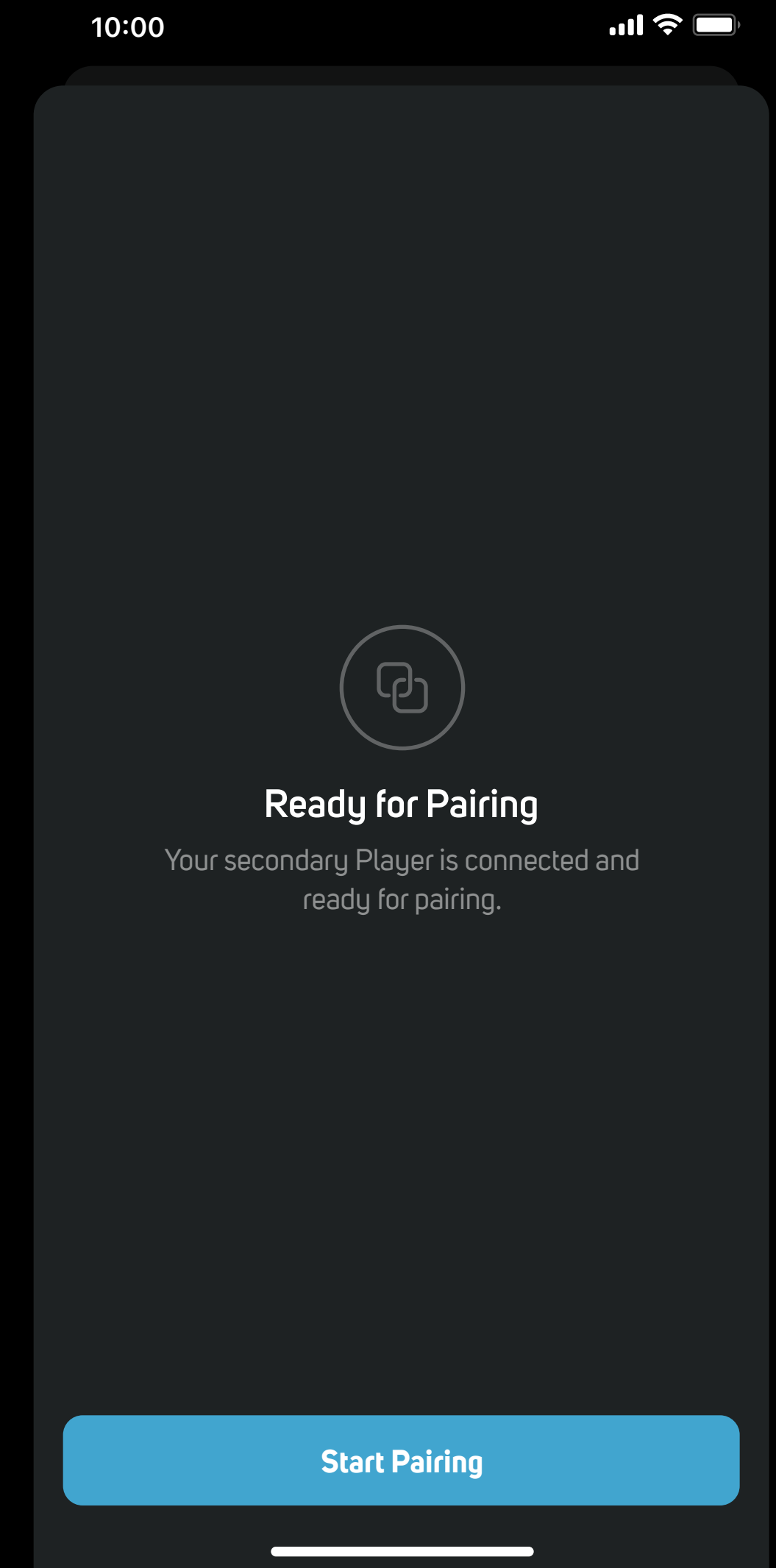
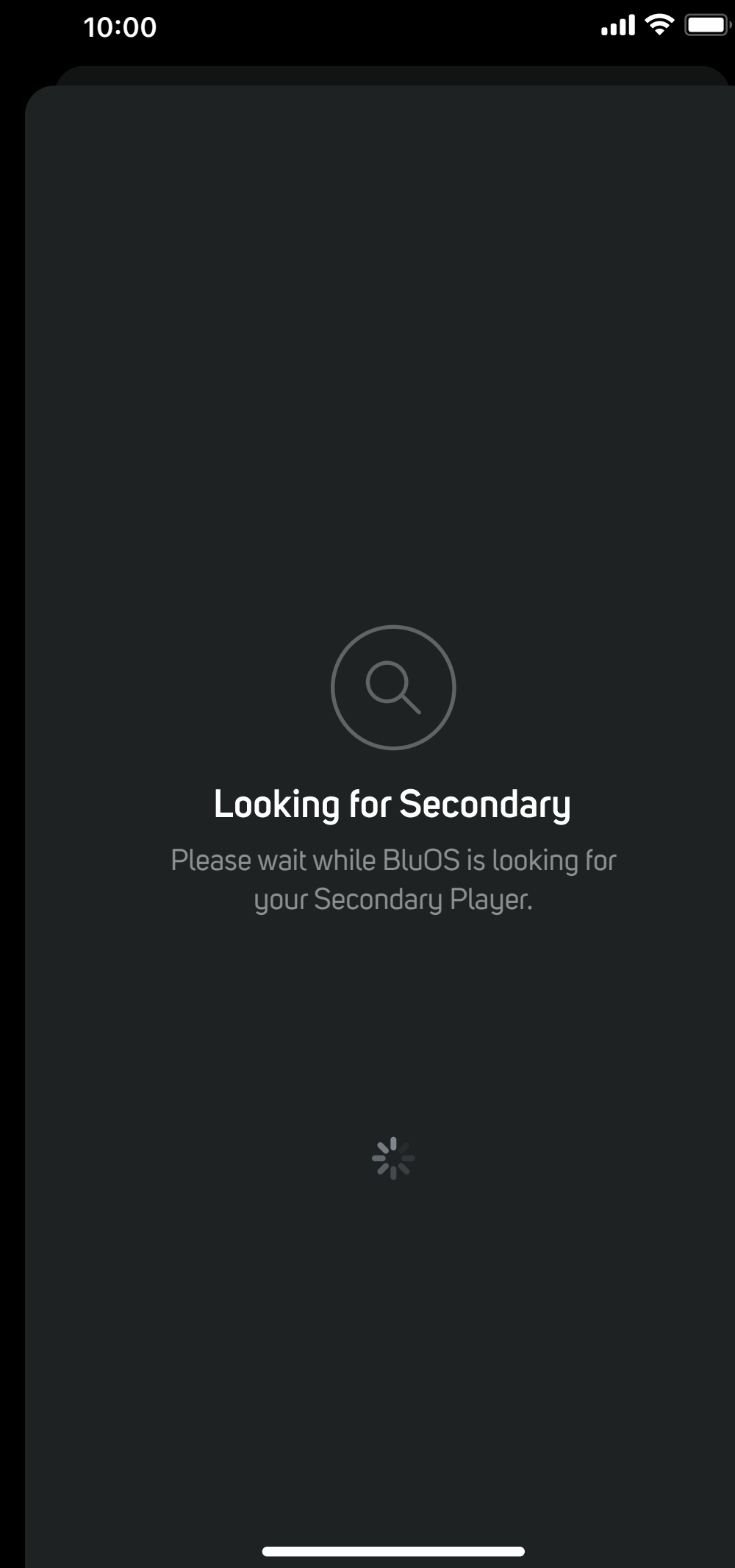
Primary Player

- First time upgrade may take up to 20 minutes



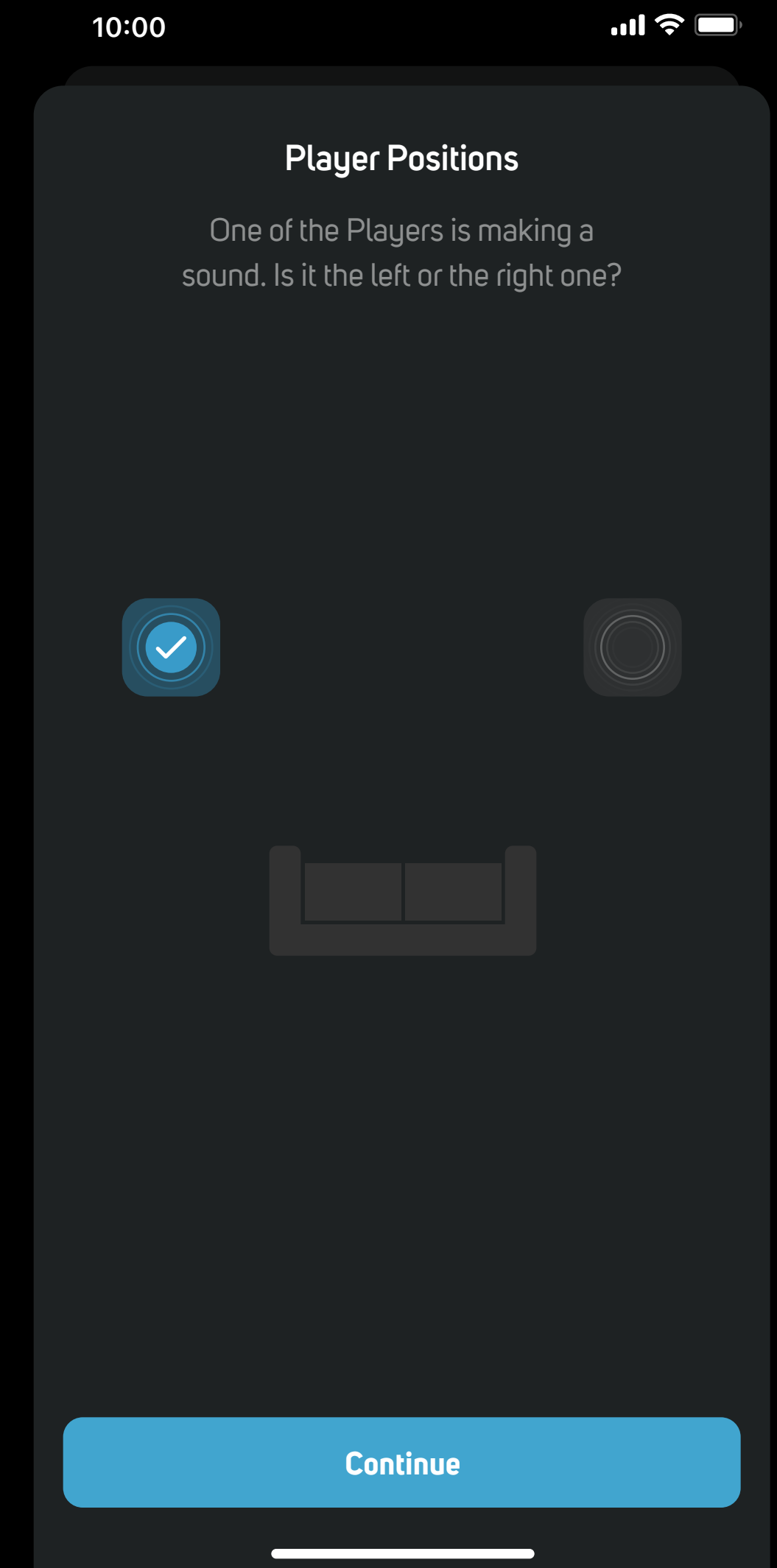
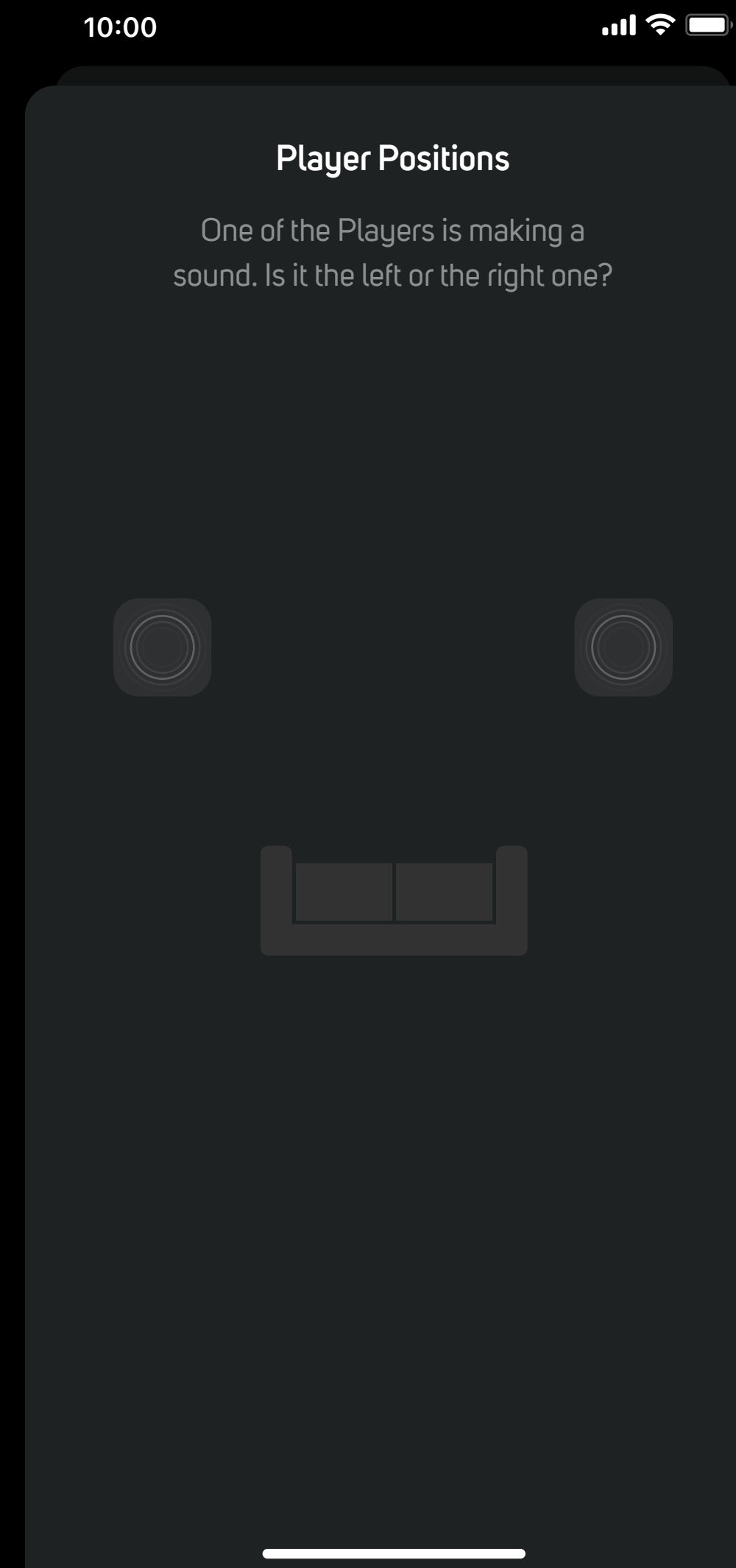
Pairing with Secondary

Player Positions

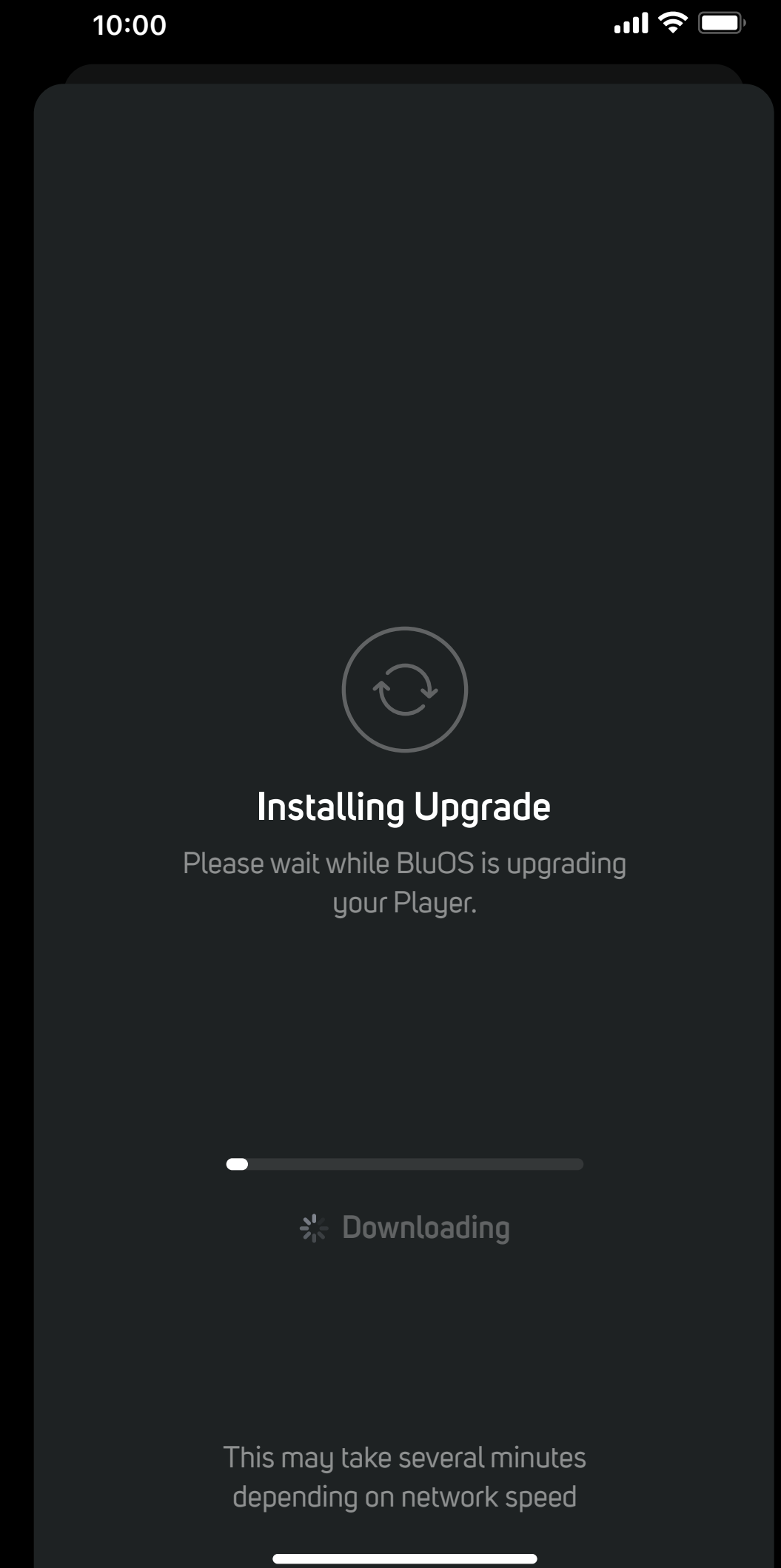
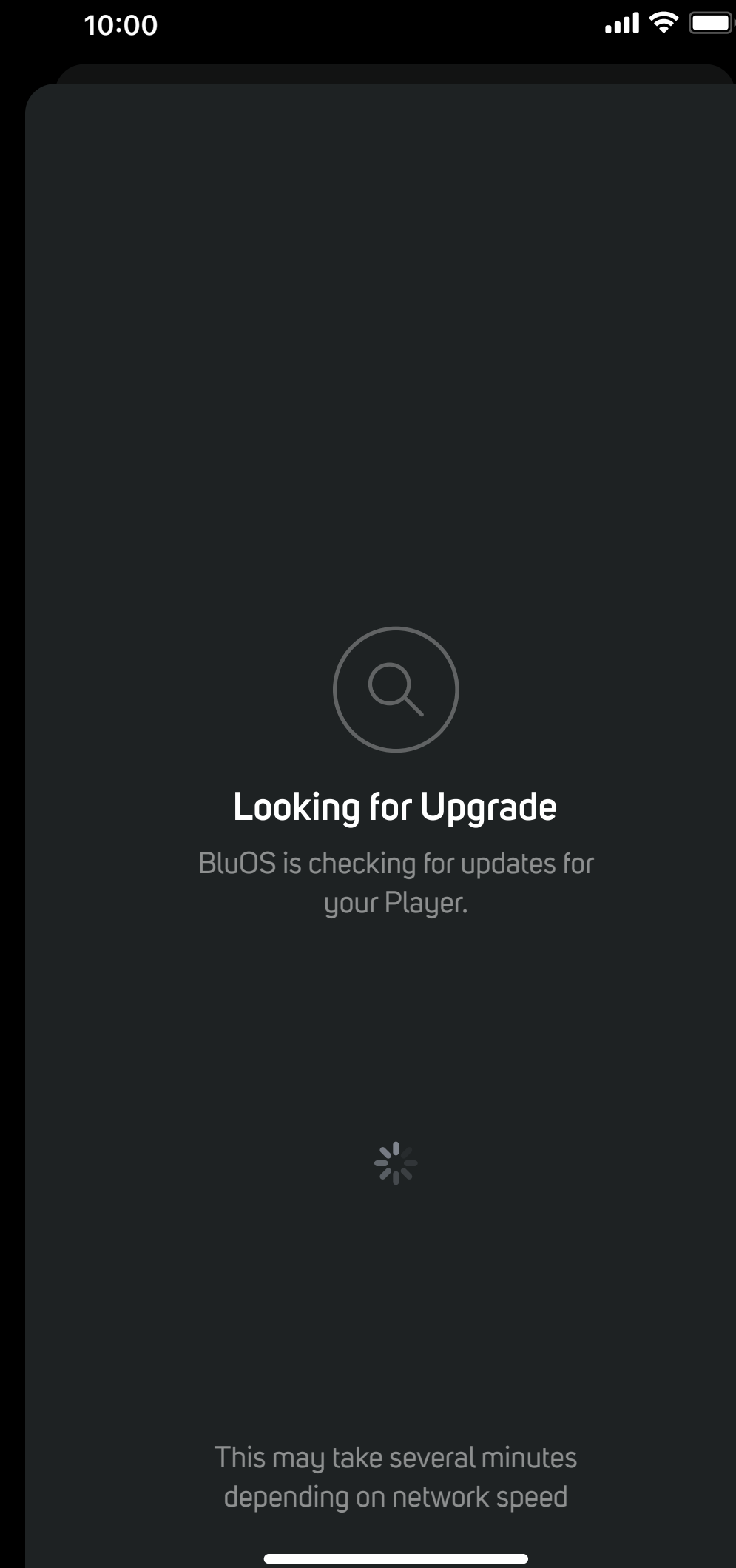
- One of the Players is playing a tune, please select whether it's the left or right one from your listening position

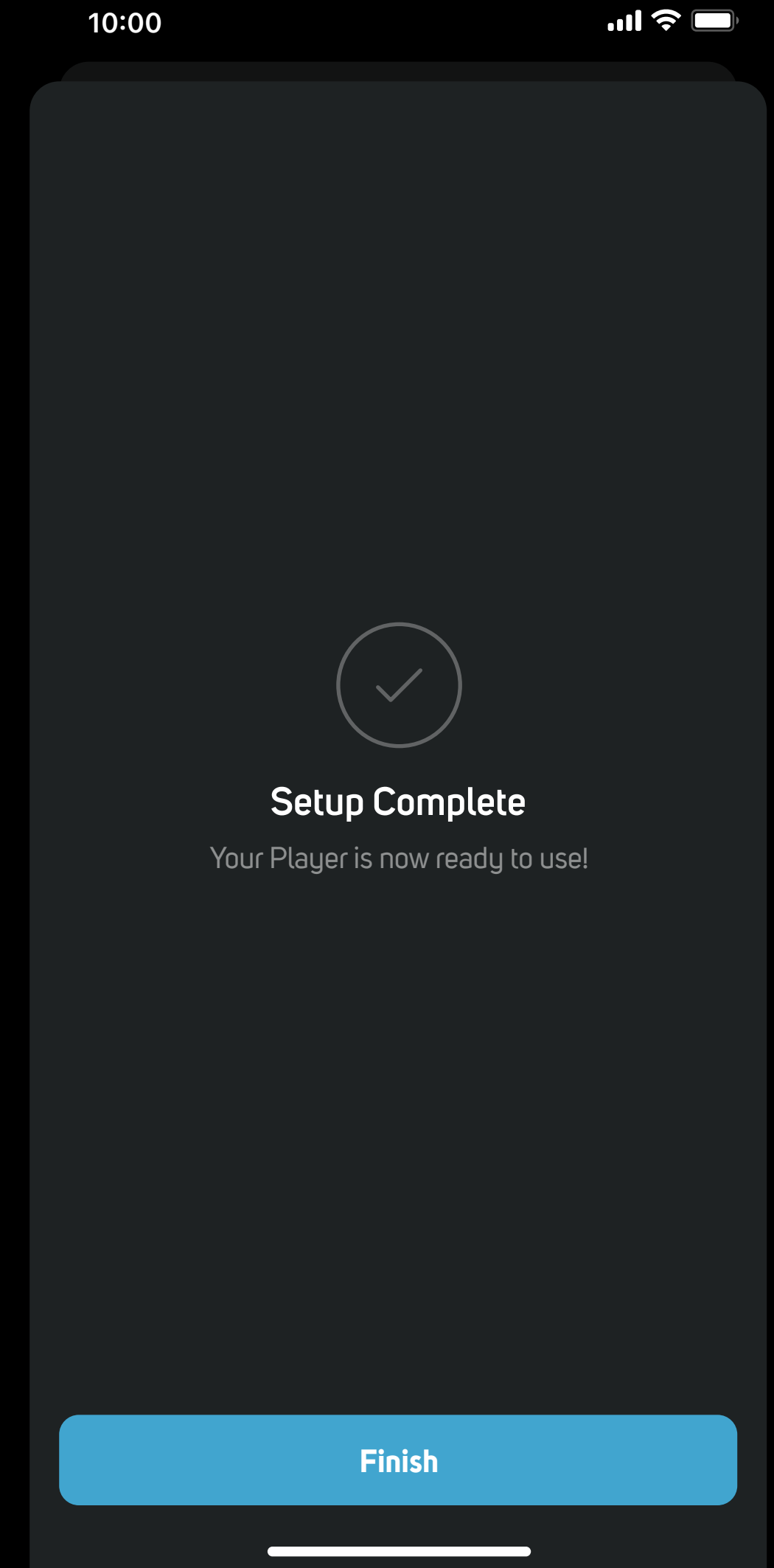
